

# Applying for a GMRS License

In order to do business with the FCC, you will need to obtain an FRN (FCC Registration Number) This number will be used in lieu of your social security number. If you already have an FRN, go to the next section. Otherwise, create an account on the FCC [CORES \(Commission Registration System\)](#). Upon completion of the application, you will instantly be assigned an FRN, a 10 digit number. Record your FRN and remember your password.


